They race each other on toy cars.



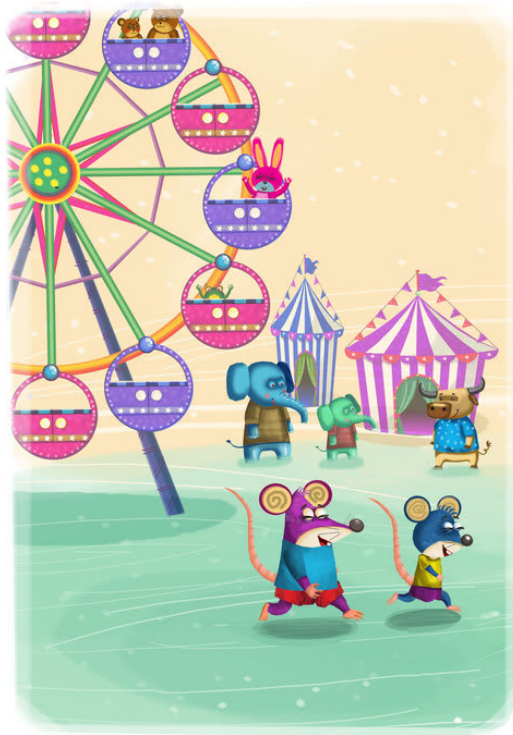
They go up and down on the merry-go-round.

Tiny Mouse isn't there.



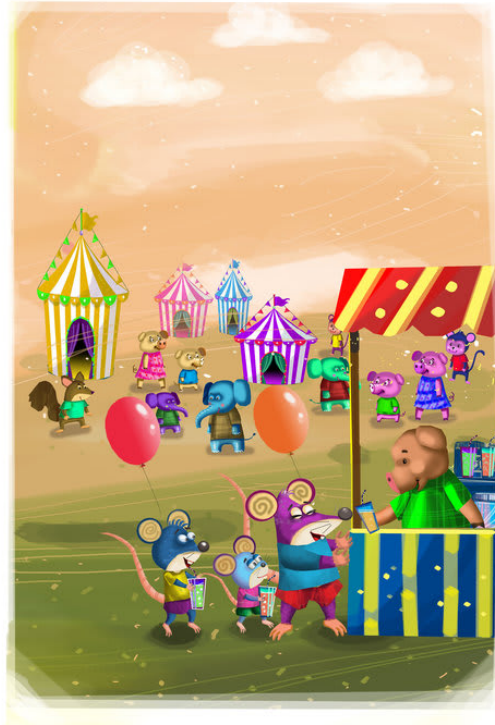
They run to the merry-go-round.
